1. Jonathan's feedback from RCLFA meeting Mon 17 August

- Problems with referees due to transport, costs. Suggested higher fees for refs, system where training fees can be paid off over time as refs earn.
- Jonathan concerned that home teams pay refs; room for bribery?
- Ok if players want to join La Liga
- RCLFA (LFA) call for comments on constitution – Jonathan to ask for copy. Jonathan
- LFA undertaking a forensic audit but this may be a slow process
- DSCJ has submitted our constitution to LFA (Natalie confirmed with Birte).
- Possible tournament in November – 7v7 or 5v5, once league is almost finished. Hosts can sell refreshments to build funds. All keen.
- Players ages in matches: If players are only a little older than their age group (a few months) than they may still be able to play in that group. (this should be discussed before game). However, opposing team can query players if age difference seems significant.
